AMP6500 End-of-Life Notice

Dear Partner,

The PCI Security Standards Council has mandated that all payment terminals certified under **PCI PTS v5** will no longer be approved after April 30, 2027. This is an industry-wide transition affecting all manufacturers with PCI PTS v5 certified devices.

The **AMP6500** is certified under PCI PTS v5. This notice formally outlines your migration timeline so you can plan with confidence.

Milestone	What this means for you	Date
End of sale	The AMP6500 will no longer be available for new purchase after this date.	July 30, 2026
PCI PTS v5 compliance sunset	The PCI Security Standards Council's approval of PCI PTS v5 devices expires. After this date, AMP6500 terminals are no longer PCI-compliant for new deployments. Customers operating these devices after this date may be subject to acquirer penalties or compliance restrictions.	April 30, 2027
End of maintenance support	Scheduled bug fixes and quality updates for the AMP6500 end on this date. Security and compliance patches may be issued at AMP's discretion.	April 30, 2027
End of service	All after-sales support, repairs, and service for the AMP6500 end on this date.	April 30, 2029

Your upgrade path

We recommend upgrading to our new Smart unattended terminals; the **AMP6400** or **AMP6600**. Both are certified under PCI PTS v6 and in active production, ensuring your environment remains compliant well beyond the 2027 sunset. Your AMP account representative can assess your deployment and build a migration plan that fits your needs.
